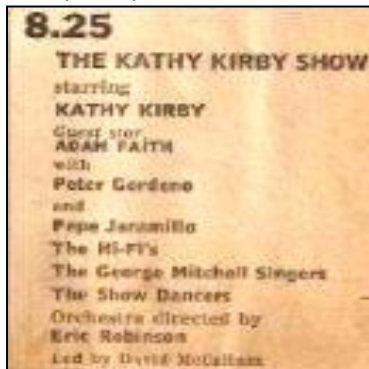

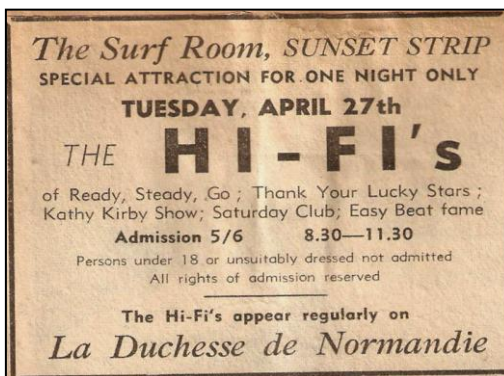

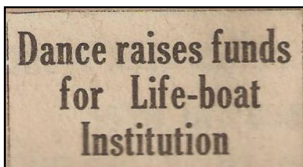

*We were booked to play on the tiny Channel Island of Sark, to commemorate the 4<sup>th</sup> Centenary of the family who owned/governed the island. Getting onto the island was going to be interesting to say the least! S.S. Sooty ("la Duchesse Du Normandie") was too big to get into their tiny harbour so we had to be ferried by smaller boat. A rowing boat!*

*The fun started when they sent their Pilot out to guide S.S.Sooty in as close as possible. There was quite a swell on the sea and when the Pilot boat came alongside, he missed his footing and fell into the sea. One of the "deckies" threw a life-belt to him and the boat went round and picked him up. Looking very embarrassed, as he was soaked to the skin.*

*When the rowing boat came to get us, we were convinced that all of our instruments were destined for Davey Jones' Locker. It took three trips back and forth to get it all on land much to our relief. The Dame of Sark was a lovely, elegant and classy Lady. The dance was a brilliant success and they really looked after us well. After we'd finished playing, we had a couple of drinks. Well, a few more than a couple really.*

*When it came to getting to the hotel at the other end of the island where we were staying, it was pitch black. Of course there are no street lights. No streets actually. No cars. Only bikes and no one was in a fit state to ride a bike. So, we walked the cliff-edge pathway lit by a nearby lighthouse. I kid you not! At one stage, Wrigthy was walking along, gingerly touching the electric fence that kept the island sheep away from the cliff edge. It was only low voltage but he wouldn't have felt it anyway in his condition.*

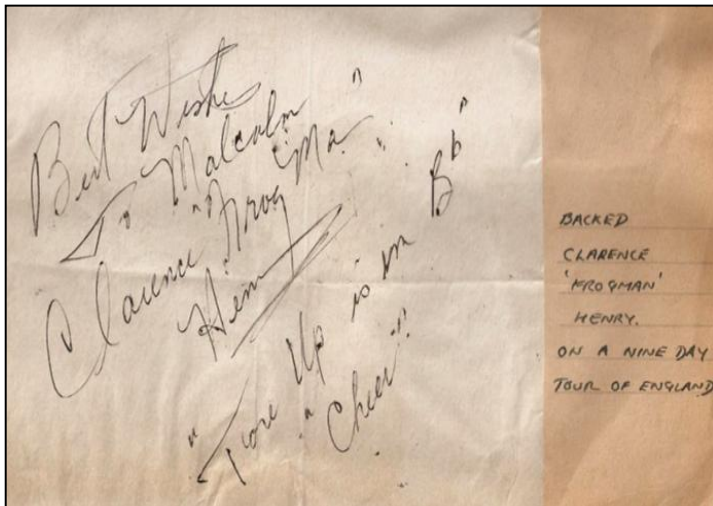
